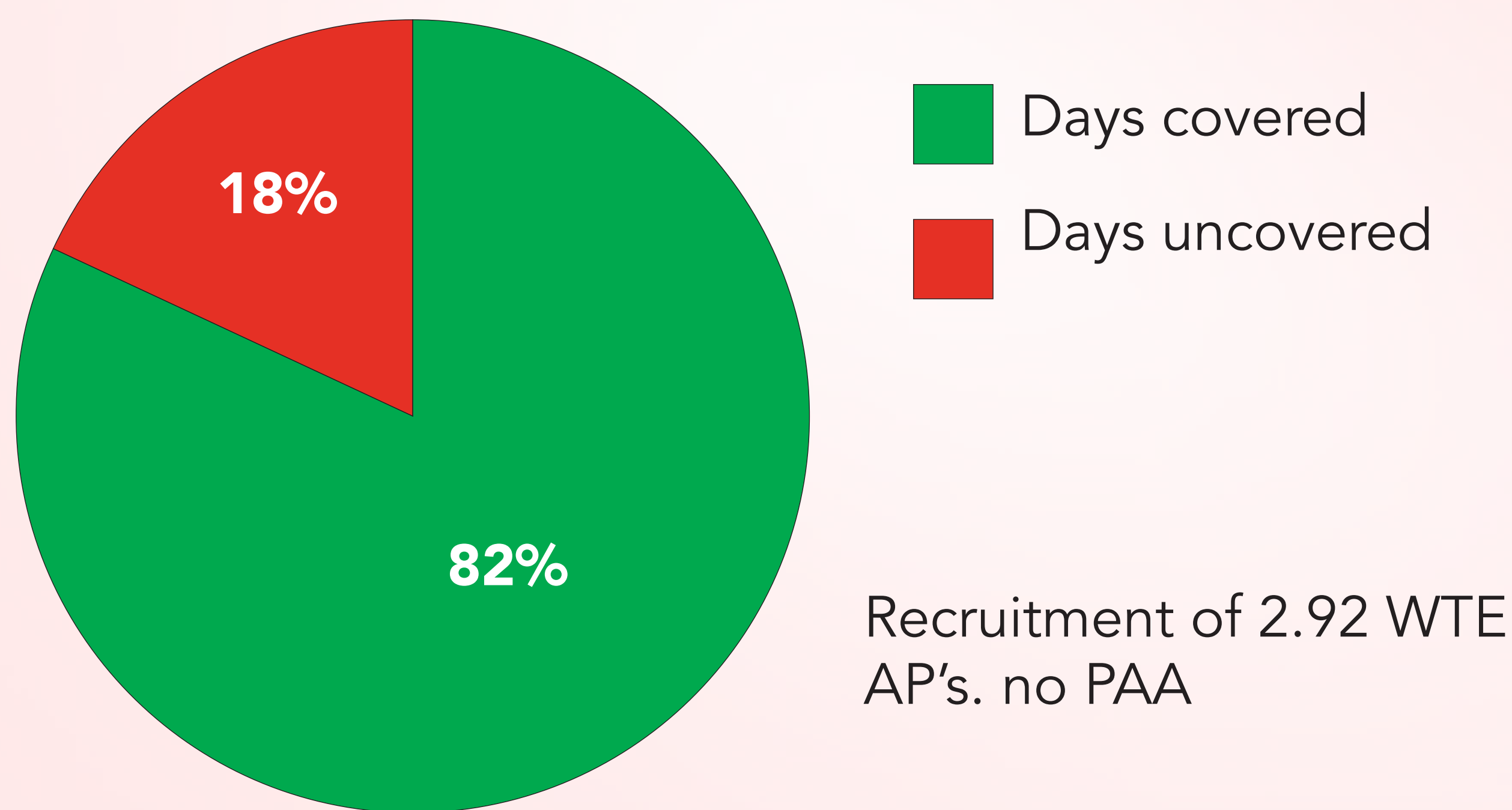

APNP Cover 2023-2024



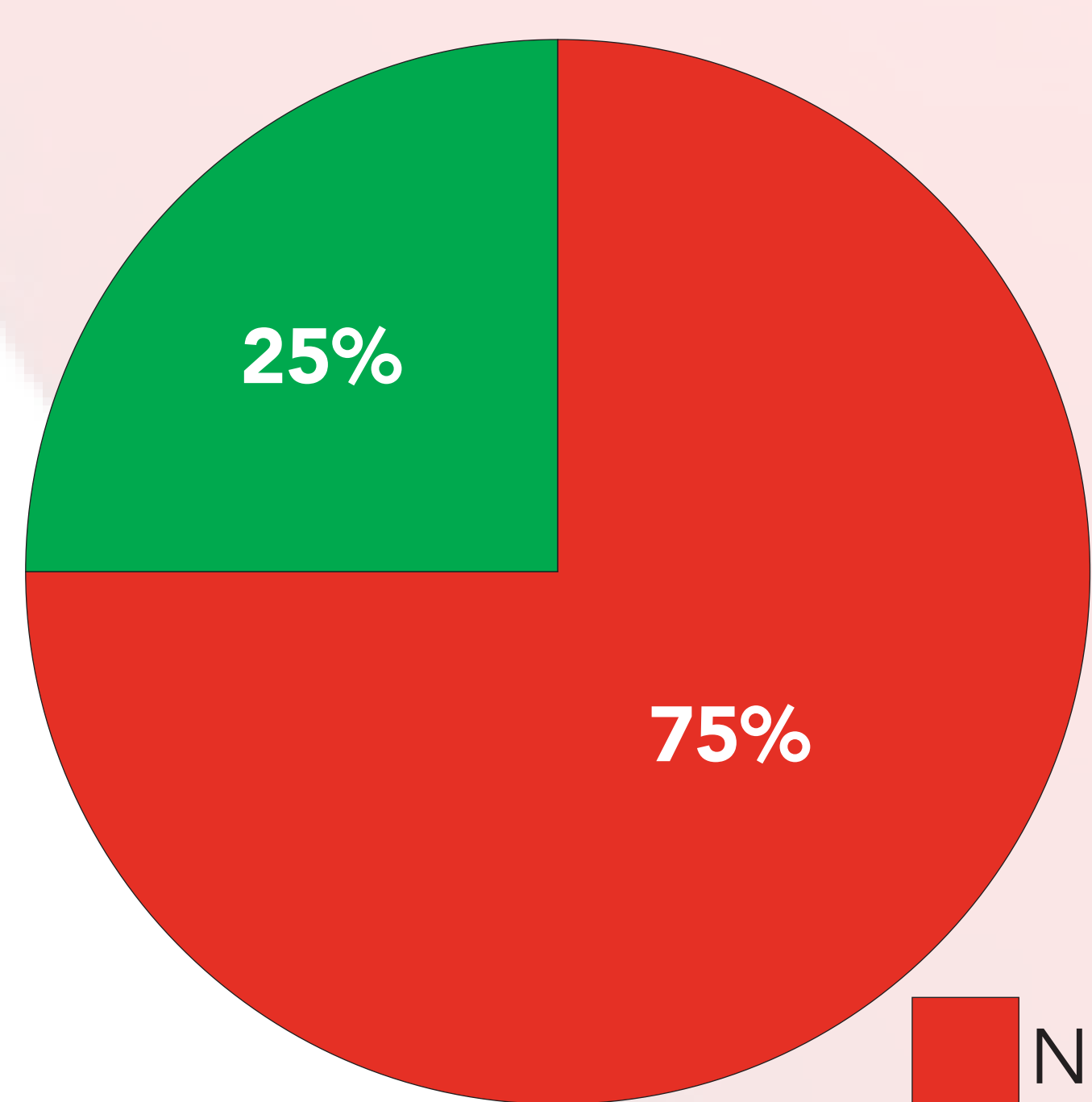

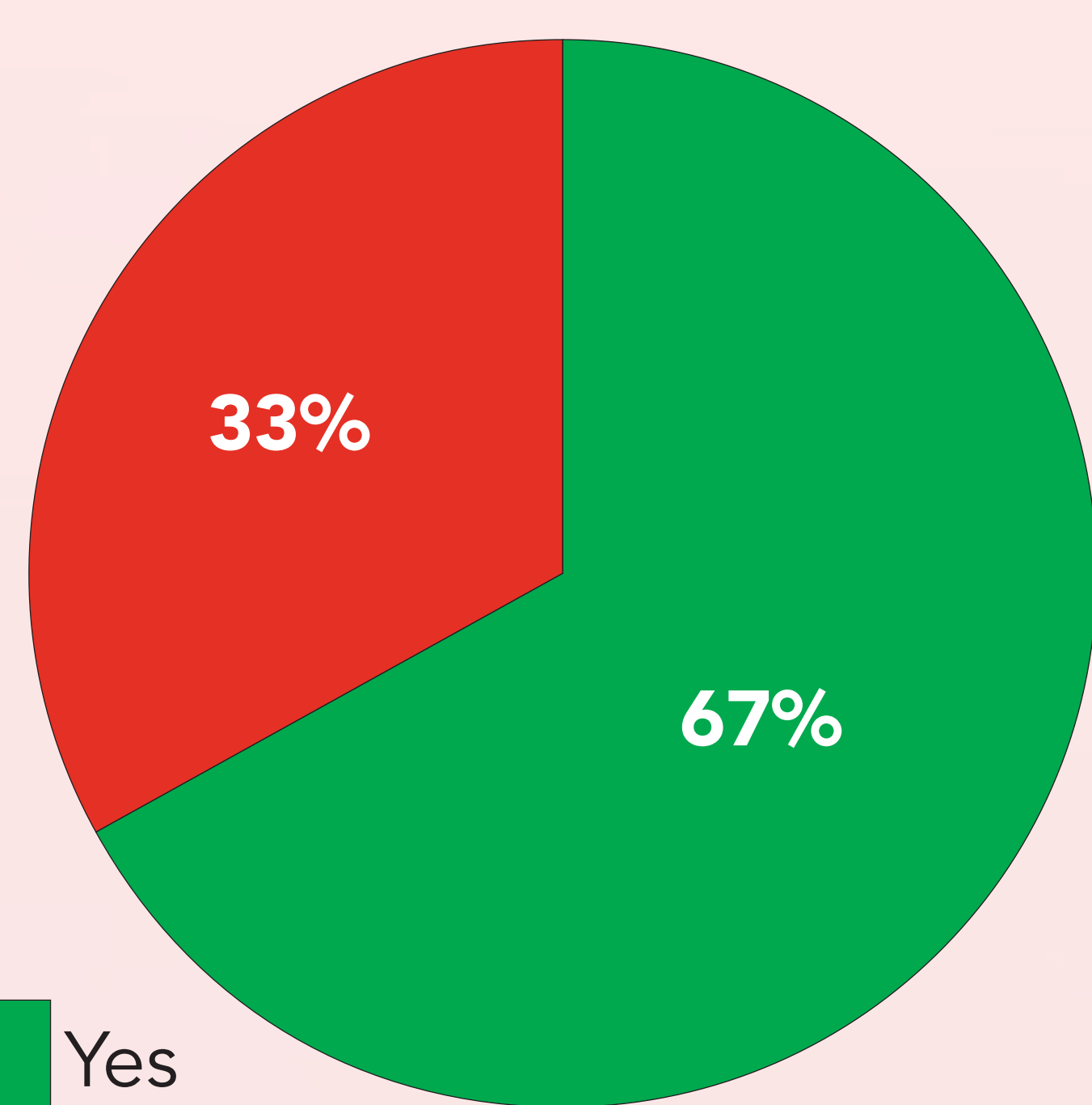

Re-audit 2023

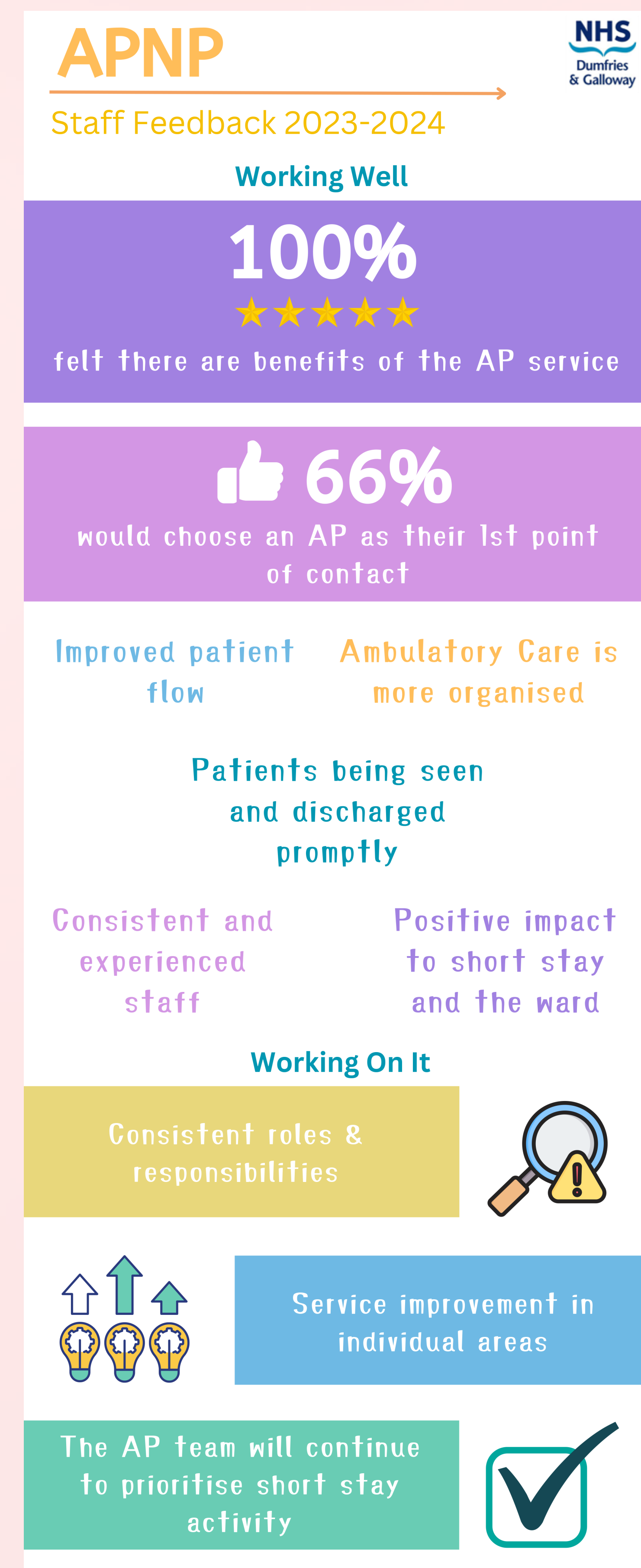


Diabetes Data

- ♥ Pre Audit (Minimal APNP input) - Average length of stay for newly diagnosed - 4 days
- ♥ Post Audit (Increasing APNP input) - Average length of stay for newly diagnosed 3.5 days

Objectives

- ♥ Development of AP Team
- ♥ Supportive of acute ward team
- ♥ Improve Ambulatory Service
- ♥ Improve flow of emergency referrals to short stay
- ♥ Improve in-patient Diabetes service
- ♥ Improve local Epilepsy service
- ♥ Improve local Oncology service



Epilepsy Data

- ♥ 100% said the information session met their learning expectations
- ♥ 100% said the information was well delivered at an appropriate level for them
- ♥ 93% said everything was delivered well
